Who are the Art Stars? We are it! Artists explore the world and break it down, hypothesis, make connections, experiment in the unknown, the undocumented. Open to all mediums whether you work in wood or computer monitors, new technologies or old, show us your thoughts. How do you internalize your theories? Synthesis and understanding through exploration, the deep of deep exploration. If you choose, enter a statement about your work including narratives, experiments, equations or such for the jurors.

ELIGIBILITY

You may enter **Art Stars/ Art and Science** if:

- 1) You are a member of the Escondido Arts Partnership, OR
- 2) You live or work in Escondido, OR
- 3) You belong to an Escondido-based arts organization

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$25.00 (\$20.00 for EAP members) for **one or two pieces** and is non-refundable. One (1) or two (2) pieces may be accepted into the exhibition.

PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS FOR A/S

- 1) Artists are to fill out gallery-provided labels for each piece brought in for jurying, and to attach labels to the back of each work.
- 2) Work must have been completed within the past two years. Work previously exhibited at the Escondido Municipal Gallery will not be accepted for jurying.

If you anticipate that your work requires atypical hanging or display techniques, or if you simply aren't sure, please be advised to contact the gallery prior to delivery dates for clearance. Special hanging, display and/or lighting requirements will be at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee. If you need a computer monitor let us know when you turn in your work.

Entry fees are non-refundable, so please call EAP at (760) 480-4101 if you have questions regarding these requirements.

LIABILITY

The greatest possible care will be taken in handling art works. The EAP and/or the City of Escondido, or their agents will not be responsible for loss or damage to any work submitted.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK FOR JURYING

Work must be hand-delivered on receiving dates, during the hours noted, **or by appointment only**. **Absolutely NO exceptions**
